Jurisdiction:

Held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations for Track Racing, the ACU Championship Conditions and the Supplementary Regulations issued for the event, together with any Final Instructions that may be issued.

NOTE: Competitors must be aware of NSC.7.15: A Entrant and/or rider shall be responsible for all acts or omissions of the parts of his riders, mechanics, passengers or any member of his entourage, but each shall be equally responsible for any infringement of the Code.

A parent or legal guardian of a rider or passenger participating in a competition requiring consent, is deemed to bear mutual responsibility together with the competitor.

Eligibility:

- a) Adult Entrants invited to compete in the ACU British Championship must hold a current National competition license issued by the ACU OR THE Scottish ACU and be a registered member of a club affiliated to the ACU. Youth must hold a current competition license issued by the ACU or the Scottish ACU and be a registered member of club affiliated to the ACU.
- b) Please note that by accepting this invitation, any driver entering the British Grass Track Championship MUST make themselves available to compete. Any driver who refuses to compete in the British Championship, (having previously entered), WILL NOT be allowed to compete in any other meeting on that date and may incur a fine.
- c) The competition will consist of the following drivers who will be selected from the 2025 National GT140 Grading list along with Wild Card entrants nominated by the club and agreed by the ACU adult Solo entry –
 - 1. 24 invited riders and 2 reserves

Youth Solo Riders – open to all eligible riders

Clubman's Sidecar entries will be accepted with restricted license and one day licenses will be available.

Note; if deemed necessary the support classes will be cancelled or races reduced if an incident occurs delaying the meeting, Championship classes will take precedence at all times.

Race Format

Event 1

Adults

Total entry 24 Plus 2 reserves

No of competitors in each heat 8

Heats per competitor 4

Total number of heats 12

Last Chance Race 1

A Final 1

All races will be staged over four laps unless any races must be shortened due to safety reasons.

Event 2-7 8 competitors in each heat, 5 rides per competitor highest point scorer is the winner

Event 7 Total entry 12, 6 competitors in each heat, 4 rides each team, 6 highest point scorers to a sudden death winner takes all final.

Ties:

Intermediate/ Semi Final Standings:

- a) Count back: Defined by the highest number of 1st places, 2nd places etc.
NOTE: a finish is considered better than a non-finish.
- b) Position in the last race where the riders met.
- c) Last race result (where there has been a differential).
- d) A ballot (in the presence of the Steward).

Final:

- a) The finishing position in the Final race will solve all ties.
- b) In the event of the Final race being unable to run, the winner will be decided by the Intermediate standings.

Please note no final will be run for youth, highest points scorer is the winner.

Entries:

All entries must be completed online via the Club Entry System

with the correct fee (£30 youth £50 Adults including 2 people into Sundays Meeting) If you're not staying please ask at the exit gate for a £10 refund, Sidecars £50 **Support classes** no later than **Wednesday 16th September**

Roping:

Please note for all ACU Track Racing championship events, the 'Alternative' roping method' **IS NOT PERMITTED.**

Cancellation of an Event:

Following a decision by the Clerk of the Course and the Stewards that the meeting has to be cancelled due to adverse weather conditions, and a final result /clarification cannot be achieved, then the result will be declared after all riders have completed **THREE** of their qualifying rides.

NOTE: All ACU Championship events must be held under the ACU PREMIER Insurance.

Environmental Mats:

Please note that for ALL Track Racing events, competitors must provide and use an environmental mat per motorcycle. The use of environmental mats is **COMPULSORY**

If competitor's use personal generators, compressors, or other similar petrol/diesel devices within their pit area, **then they too must be placed on an environmental mat** to ensure that no spills or leakage gets into the ground.

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Technical Inspection: Competitors must present themselves together with their motorcycles, helmets, clothing etc., to the Technical Officials before starting engines.

A change of motorcycle within a particular class may be permitted at any stage of the event (including the rerun of any races), subject to the approval of the Clerk of the Course, providing that the motorcycle has been passed by the Technical Steward and bears the correct riding numbers. Any motorcycle involved in an accident must be available for re-examination before being allowed to be used again. All motorcycles, clothing and helmets must be passed by the Technical Steward before a rider/passenger is allowed to practice.

Note: All motorcycles used in the final race of each class will be impounded in a Parc Ferme area, in accordance with the National Sporting Code. The first three motorcycles in each class will be subject to a final examination in accordance with Grass Track Standing Regulations 2.4.
